The function of the State Board for Wildlife will be to advise the State Government:-

- (a) In the selection and management of areas to be declared as Protected Areas ;
- (b) In formulation of the policy for protection and conservation of wildlife and specified plants ;
- (c) In any matter relating to the amendment of any schedule ;
- (d) In relation to the measure to be taken for harmonizing the needs of the tribal and other dwellers of the forest with the protection and conservation of wildlife; and
- (e) In any matter connected with the protection of wildlife which may be referred to it by the State Government.

The Board shall meet at least twice a year at such place as the State Government may direct. Travelling allowances and daily allowances will be payable to non-official members of the Board as admissible to grade 1 Officers of the Government of West Bengal.

Resolved that this Resolution to be published in the Kolkata Gazette.
