
13.	Contractor(s) eligible to submit tender	=	Listed contractors of PWD, CPWD, MES, Railway and other bonafide contractors having sufficient and adequate credentials of 60% of total estimated cost of similar type of works.
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TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. No Tender will be accepted unless the tenderer proves that he / she is a citizen of India.
2. Tenderers must submit tenders in sealed cover by registered post / courier post addressing by name to Sri.K.Sarkar, WBFS, Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division, West Bengal & super scribing the works' **"Tender for Dismantling of existing wove wire fencing and erection of Chain link fencing"** on the envelope.
3. Tenderers must enclose the photocopies of valid VAT & IT clearance certificates & credentials for doing similar type of job in the past along with tender. If any of the documents is not submitted along with the tender, the same shall be treated as invalid.
4. The Tenderers or their authorized representatives should be present at the time of opening of tender.
5. Each Tenderer will have to deposit Earnest Money Rs.35,000.00 (Thirty five thousand) only through Demand Draft or Pay Order in favour of the Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division along with tender without which no tender will be considered. The Earnest Money deposit of unsuccessful tenderers will be released in due course on application from the Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division, Champadali More, Opposite - Titumir Bus Stand, Barasat. The Earnest Money will not carry any interest.
6. The successful tenderer will have to pay Security Deposit @ 10% of tendered amount and sign an agreement within 5 days from the date of receipt of acceptance letter, failing to which the Earnest Money will be forfeited to Government. The Security Money will be Deposited through Demand Draft or Pay Order in favour of Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division, Barasat. The Security Money will not carry any interest. Security Money will be released to the tenderer after 6(six) months from the date of receipt of satisfactory completion report from the Range Officer concerned.
7. The Security Deposit is exclusive of compensation charge of damaged property, if any, so occur afterwards in connection with the execution of the work and successful tenderer will be responsible for compensation etc., if required, as stated above.
8. In the event of failure on part of successful tenderer to Deposit the Security Money to sign the agreement within stipulated time, the Earnest Money of the successful tenderer will be forfeited to the Government and the tenderer will be debarred from taking part in any tender, in future.
9. The Directorate does not undertake any risk of any damage if caused by flood, cyclone or other natural calamities or biotic factor.

10. The work order will be issued subject to availability of fund and after receipt of sanction of the work from the appropriate authority.
11. The tenderers should inspect the proposed site of work before submission of tender.
12. Subletting act, outsourcing of work is strictly prohibited and will lead to cancellation of the contract and forfeiture of Security Deposit.
13. VAT & IT will be deducted from the bills as per norms.
14. If the tenderer does not complete the work in stipulated time and leaves the work in mid way then the Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division will forfeit the Security Money Deposited by him and will have liberty to arrange to complete the job in manner suitable in the interest of the project.
15. The tenderer will remain solely responsible for any liability in respect of work and labourers engaged by him for the said purpose.
16. The tenderer should make supply of materials as per specifications given herein above and those which have been duly inspected and passed by the authorized representative of Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division at the work site.
17. No extension of time for completion of job will be allowed.
18. Works completed should be measured during the last two working days by the concerned Range Officer/ Beat Officer.
19. The tenderer fulfilling the above conditions can obtain the tender document from the Office of the Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division, Barasat.
20. The undersigned will not be bound to accept the lowest rate offered and will not be liable to assign any reason thereof.
21. The tenderer shall be bound to execute the work according to the direction given from time to time by the undersigned or his authorized officer of this Division and any complaint against the tenderer from the said officer for deviation from this direction will cause violation of the condition of the contract and to forfeiture of the Security Money.
22. In case of any dispute the decision of the Joint Director, Sundarban Biosphere Reserve, West Bengal will be final.
23. No departmental materials will be made available for use in the work.
24. Tenderers should quote their rates on the basis of rates shown in column (D) in the detailed estimate (i.e Annexure -I) against items of works before submission of tender. Tenders once submitted and accepted, no alteration or deviation to this effect shall be entertained.

25. The tenderer should be reputed, reliable, experienced and resourceful contractors having knowledge of doing similar nature of work in the past. In case of partnership concern, proper document should be submitted/ made available along with the tender.
26. The undersigned reserves the right to reject any or all the tenderers without assigning any reasons thereof.
27. The tenderers should quote their rates as per format supplied with the tender paper.
28. Supply of materials will be of best quality as per specifications and will have to be at the full satisfaction of the undersigned or his authorized officer. The authority shall have the power to reject at any stage the defective and / or inferior materials/ components and the replacement shall be made at once at the contractor's own expenses.
29. The eligible tenderers shall have to collect the tender document / tender paper from the Attached Forest Ranger, 24 Parganas (North) Division in between 11.00 AM to 2.00 PM on 29/12/2011 & 30/12/2011 on production of credentials.
30. After completion of the tendered job a satisfactory completion report shall have to be handed over to the authority for enabling necessary payment. The Tenderer will be paid by A/C Payee Cheque after receipt of work measurement notebook reference, challan & voucher from the concerned Range Officer or part bill may be allowed as per discretion of the Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division . Final payment after due completion of works will be made from the concerned Divisional Forest Officer, 24 Parganas (North) Division as per requisition of the said payment after the Demand Claim.
